



Fall Floral Arrangement

Supply List

- Vase or Piece of Pottery
- Golden Cluster of Feathers
- Orange Artificial Branches
- Tan Artificial Branches
- Wire Cutters

Step 1:

It all starts with the inspiration pottery. Mine is a bluish green at the bottom with cream and sparkling brown glaze at the top. Use the colors in your inspiration piece to help direct you for your artificial flower selections. What is important is that you choose two stems that are at least 18 inches tall and a shorter one in a pop of color. The more variations in texture you can purchase, the better.

Step 2:

Once you have your stems selected, group them together in your hand. Allow the two tallest ones to be beside one another in the back and the shorter feather arrangement to rest in front of them. Once you are happy with how they look, secure the three stems together with a rubber band. This will keep them nice and tight once they are placed in the vase.

Clip the ends of the stems with a pair of wire cutters and slide the flowers into your vase. Now it is time to find a beautiful home for your new arrangement.

Tip:

Each stem should be a different color but all should coordinate with one another.
